Family Services' Nicole Queen Nominated in the Category of Child Care Center Director at the 2013 Bammy Awards

(Gaithersburg, MD) -- Family Services, Inc. (FSI) is proud to announce that Nicole Queen, Center Director for FSI's Watch Me Grow Child Development Center, has been nominated for honors in the category of Child Care Center Director at the 2013 Bammy Awards.

Presented by the Academy of Education Arts and Sciences International, the Bammy Award is a cross-discipline award recognizing the contributions of educators from across the education field.

In 2009, Family Services opened Watch Me Grow Child Development Center in Clarksburg, Maryland, with Nicole as the Center Director. Many students have shown their support by spending their personal time attending community events that have been sponsored by Watch Me Grow. A workshop was created specifically for parents in concern to kindergarten readiness, and how best to prepare your child for school. The event was a success, with over 40 parents in attendance. Watch Me Grow feels that every child and family deserve the absolute best for their children and they simply will not stand for anything less.

"Nominees like Nicole are making a difference in education every day. It's more important now than ever to publicly honor educators and to show what's right with American Education," said Errol St. Clair Smith, Executive Producer of the Bammy Awards.
